2010 Update:

(A) Merchandising: (Canex & PSP) Canex has reduced prices on some of their clothing to date sale of 2010 (Canex) & (PSP) items have greatly exceeded expectations, Sold 208 swords to date.

(B) Website: Unfortunately the contract for the 2010 website webmaster has run out and a new webmaster should be on board shortly. All activities will be updated at this time.

(C) National Day of Recognition: 04 May 2010. This is in the Prime ministers Office for approval now.

(D) National Naval Monument: Sod will be turned on 4 May 2010 at Richmond Lannding in Ottawa. The whole site structure will be ready and unveiled 4 May 2011.

(E) Stamps: Two stamps have been approved and will be launched by 4 May 2010

- (F) Circulation Coin: There is no problem it is up for government approval now. It will have HMCS Ottawa with sailor and female officer on.
- (G) Centennial Bell: It has been produced and ready for presentation to Parliament on 4 May 2010.
- (H) Namesake Project: Approximately 60% finished now. All reports seem to be favourable.

- (K) Serving Member Certificate: An official certificate signed by the PM and Governor-General is being issued to all serving Naval Members.
- (L) Canadian War Museum: The travelling Naval Art Show which includes our set of six (2010) special paintings is on the road now to aart centres in major cities and should be back for display in the war museum by the end of summer.
- (M) NCR Committee Involved with national centennial ball, tulip festival, proclamation of Canada Day.
